
CHOUTEAU 1-35 TIF PLAN 8TH AMENDMENT

- Redeveloper for Projects 3 and 4 Chouteau Crossings West, LLC




CHOUTEAU 1-35 TIF PLAN

Generally bounded by I-35 on the north,
Antioch on the west,
North Brighton on the east, and Parvin Road on the south.


CHOUTEAU I-35 TIF PLAN OVERVIEW

The original plan was to remediate blight in a undeveloped property that previously consisted of the bed of a former lake and modest commercial development.



CHOUTEAU I-35 TIF PLAN

Redevelopment Area included Target, a grocery store and other retail, street and park improvements, and a housing rehabilitation program.



CHOUTEAU 1-35 TIF PLAN PROJECTS 3 & 4

Project 3 consisted of a McDonalds

Project 4 was not undertaken

CHAMP- CHOUTEAU HOUSING AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

The Commission has expended \$1.3 million (including \$335,000 in matching funds) to provide assistance to rehabilitate 328 homes in the CHAMP program.

8TH AMENDMENT

• The 8th Amendment would increase the budget by \$1,220,000 in order to (1) acquire a commercial building at 4305 N. Antioch and (2) provide funding for the construction of the Chouteau Heritage Fountain, (3) additional public improvements and (4) commission expenses.

ACQUISITION OF 4305 N. ANTIOCH



The City is requesting \$700,000 to be used for the acquisition of a commercial building at 4305 N. Antioch. The City intends to transfer the property to Brinshore Development LLC as a part of its 43 Antioch housing project.

CHOUTEAU HERITAGE FOUNTAIN



• The 8th Amendment allocates \$405,000 from future EATs from Projects 3 and 4 for public improvements, such as road, sewer, water, sidewalk, and other public improvements.

SURPLUS OF PILOTS FROM PROJECTS 3 AND 4

•Upon approval of the 8th Amendment, the Commission will surplus \$143,000 in PILOTs and also surplus the future PILOTs from Projects 3 and 4.

RECOMMENDATION

• The Tax Increment Financing Commission recommends approval of the 8th Amendment.
