**Brief Title** **Approval Deadline**

Approving a Construction contract for the replacement of water mains in the area of Walnut Street to Bennington Avenue, and St. John Avenue to 17th Street

**Reason**

To authorize execution of a Construction contract and expenditures; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

**Details**

**Reason for Contract**

This project will be performed to replace aging, break-prone water mains with new ductile iron pipe (DIP) to increase distribution system reliability, hydraulic conveyance capacity, and fire protection.

**Discussion**

**Project Justification**

This project will replace approximately 3,800 linear feet (LF) of aging water mains in the area of Walnut Street to Bennington Avenue, and St. John Avenue to E. 17th Street.

**Project Description**

This project consists of replacing approximately 3,800 LF of existing aging water mains with 380 LF of 6" DIP, 1,720 LF of 8" DIP, and 1,700 LF of 12" DIP. Replacement of water mains will be in the following areas:

- Along Troost Avenue from Independence Avenue to Pacific Street with 6" DIP,
- Along Walnut Street from E 3rd Street to 300 feet south of E. 3rd Street with 6" DIP,
- Along Bellefontaine Avenue from E. 17th to Benton Plaza with 6" DIP,
- Along E. 16th Street from Brooklyn Avenue to Garfield Avenue with 6" DIP,
- Along E. Winner Road from Hardesty Avenue to E. 12th Street with 6" DIP,
- Along E. Truman Road from Askew Avenue to Cleveland Avenue with 8" DIP, and
- Along Bennington Avenue from St. John Avenue to Wilson Road with 12" DIP.

This work will include the transfer of customers' water service connections from the existing mains to the new mains, as well as restoration of roads and property.

All project work will be completed within Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in Council Districts 3 and 4.
