**Details**

**Reason for Contract**

This construction project will be performed to replace aging, break-prone cast iron pipe (CIP) water mains with ductile iron pipe (DIP).

**Discussion**

**Project Justification**

The Water Services Department is undertaking this construction project to improve distribution system reliability, increase hydraulic conveyance capacity, and support fire protection.

**Project Description**

This project includes the replacement of approximately 8,750 linear feet (LF) of break prone 6-inch and 8-inch water mains in the area of Bennington Avenue to James A. Reed Road, E. 63rd Street to E. 67th Street, all in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. The project will replace the water mains in the following locations:

- Replace 1,950 LF of 6-inch CIP water main with 8-inch DIP along E. 67th Street from Richmond Avenue to James A. Reed Road;
- Replace 325 LF of 2-inch PVC and 140 LF of 6-inch CIP water main with 6-inch DIP along E. 66th Terrace from James A. Reed Road towards the dead-end;
- Replace 720 LF of 8-inch CIP water main with 8-inch DIP along Manchester Avenue from E. 66th Street to E. 67th Street;
- Replace 1,315 LF of 6-inch CIP water main with 6-inch DIP along E. 66th Street from Manchester Avenue to James A. Reed Road;
- Replace 2,400 LF of 6-inch CIP water main with 8-inch DIP along James A. Reed Road from Blue Parkway Drive to E. 67th Street;
- Replace 1,220 LF of 8-inch CIP water main with 8-inch DIP along E. 66th Street from Bennington Avenue to Winchester Avenue; and
- Replace 680 LF of 8-inch CIP water main with 8-inch DIP along Winchester Avenue from E. 66th Street to E. 67th Street.
