Amending Chapter 60, Code of Ordinances, entitled Sewers and Sewage Disposal, by repealing Sections 60-2, 60-3, 60-112, 60-116, 60-117, 60-121, 60-122, 60-125, 60-126, 60-128, 60-142, 60-143, 60-155, 60-157, 60-160, 60-161, 60-181, 60-183, 60-194, and enacting in lieu thereof new sections of like number and subject matter; and establishing an effective date.

ORDINANCE NO. 230390

Amending Chapter 60, Code of Ordinances

Amends Chapter 60, Sewers and Sewerage Disposal, by updating language on water uses where large water volumes purchased is used such that is not returned to the sewer system. Also updates rates associated with hauled liquid wastes; updates commercial and industrial fees and fines, and streamlines process per Federal and state requirements to encourage best management practices in industrial and commercial waste treatment.





CHAPTER 60 UPDATES IMPACTS COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL USERS ONLY

<u>Local Discharge Limit Review</u> as required after issuance of revised NPDES Wastewater Treatment Operating Permits

- Local Discharge Limits are reviewed and updated every 5 years
- Monitors and manage metals & other constituents in wastewater
- Significant industrial users discharge flows within permitted limits
- This testing and results review manages the limits established
- No changes to existing limits this year; addition of sulfates



CHAPTER 60 UPDATES IMPACTS COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL USERS ONLY

Incorporation of the Streamlining Rule

- Federal 40 CFR Part 403 and subsequent follow-on changes to state law
- Encourages significant industrial users to use Best Management Practices
- Outcome is reducing or eliminating discharge of harmful pollutants to sanitary sewers
- Reduces overall regulatory burden on commercial and industrial users and municipalities



CHAPTER 60 UPDATES IMPACTS COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL USERS ONLY

Other Housekeeping Changes

- Ensure consistency with NPDES regulations and correct typos
- Updates fees and fines based on level of effort
- Updates the Hauled Sewage and Diverted Water Uses
