 Estimating revenue in the amount of \$12,231,786.00 in the Federal Stimulus Grants account; and authorizing Airport Coronavirus Response Grants Program (ACRGP) Grant Offers from the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

Discussion	
Description	<p>In February 2021, the Aviation Department submitted to the FAA an Airports Coronavirus Resource Grant Program (ACRGP) Application for a grant of Federal funds at or associated with the Kansas City International Airport and the Charles B. Wheeler Downtown Airport.</p> <p>The ACRGP Grant is provided in accordance with the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA Act) (H.R. 133, Public Law 116-260).</p> <p>The purpose of the ACRGP Grant is to provide funds to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus (COVID -19) and such funds must only be used for purposes directly related to the airport. Specifically, ACRGP funds can be used for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitization, janitorial services, combating the spread of pathogens at the airports, and debt service payments. Additionally, at KCI, ACRGP funds may also be used to provide relief from rent and minimum annual guarantees to on-airport parking, on-airport car rental, and in-terminal airport concessions.</p> <p>The ACRGP Grant Agreement between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, acting through its Director of the Aviation Department, and the FAA has a duration of a period of four (4) years from the date of acceptance.</p> <p>How will this contribute to a sustainable Kansas City? The ACRGP Grant will allow the Aviation Department to 1) keep the city's airports in reliable, safe operation to serve the aviation industry, the traveling public, and support the economy; 2) keep airport and aviation workers employed; and 3) maintain the stability of the Department's airport credit ratings.</p>
