### Executive Summary

Authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services Department to execute an \$760,000.00 annual contract amendment to the Management Agreement and Lease with the American Jazz Museum, Inc. for management and operations of the 18th and Vine Project; and authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to extend and amend the Agreement and Lease.

### Discussion

The City owns the 18<sup>th</sup> and Vine Project ("Project,") consisting of improvements in the area bounded by 17<sup>th</sup> Street Terrace, 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Vine Street and Highland Avenue, and the Gem Theater, 1615 East 18<sup>th</sup> Street. The Project includes the American Jazz Museum, the Blue Room, the Horace Peterson III 18th and Vine Visitor Center, the tenant space for the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum, and the Gem Theater. The City currently contracts with and has a lease with the American Jazz Museum, Inc., a Missouri non-profit corporation, ("AJM") for the management and operation of the Project except for the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum which is leased and managed by the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum, Inc. The City and AJM previously entered into Management and Lease Agreements ("Agreement and Lease").
