Reason for Legislation
<p>To accept funding in the amount of \$890,183.00 as part of the Ryan White HIV Emergency Relief Part A/ Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) Grant from the Department of Health and Human Services Administration (HRSA) and to appropriate funding to associated City fiscal years. This grant is effective from March 1, 2020 to February 28, 2021. This represents the full grant award for the indicated time period.</p>

Discussion
<p>The purpose of this contract is to ensure all residents living with HIV/AIDS within the 11 county Kansas City Transitional Grant Area (KC-TGA) have access to medical care and support services. This area consist of Cass, Clay, Clinton, Jackson, Platte, Lafayette, and Ray counties in MO and Johnson, Leavenworth, Miami, and Wyandotte counties in KS.</p> <p>The KC-TGA Ryan White Continuum of Care provided HIV/AIDS services for 2,748 unduplicated clients during the period from January 2019 to December 2019 (CY19). These services are provided by seven different agencies (THRIVE Health Connection, Kansas City CARE Health Center, Truman Medical Center, the University of Kansas Hospital, reStart Inc., SAVE Inc., and NextGen). This comprehensive system of care is monitored for the quality, programatic and fiscal integrity by the Kansas City Missouri Health Department, HIV Services Program.</p> <p>Ryan White funding is appropriated annually by the U.S. Congress. The awards for Part A are split into formula and supplemental funds. Formula funds are awarded based on the number of new cases of HIV/AIDS in the funded service area. Supplemental funds are awarded based on demonstrated need and quality of local plans in the annual application.</p> <p>This funding resrepents a partial formula award due to Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) operating under a Continuing Resolution. The FY20 Ryan White Part A award represents the 26th year of this program.</p>

How will this contribute to a sustainable Kansas City?

Quality health care directly impacts the economic vitality, social and environmental quality of a community. Promoting and protecting citizens of Kansas City is the goal of all public health programs. Individuals living with HIV/AIDS are required to enroll in Medical Case Management to receive access to Ryan White Part A core medical & support services. Funding for health insurance and primary care services ensures residents living with HIV/AIDS, within the KC-TGA, receive appropriate health care services and treatment of their disease through federal and local funding.

Is it good for the children?

Yes, these services are provided to children and youth living with HIV/AIDS. During CY19, 560 (20.3%) of clients served were women, youth, infants, and/or children.
