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<p>Discussion :</p> <p>Is it good for the children? Yes</p> <p>The proposed changes to the MWBE Ordinance are summarized below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Establish annual City-Wide target goals of 14.7% MBE, and 14.4% for WBE. The target goals would not apply to every contract. Each contract would continue to be evaluated and goals established based on the availability of ready, willing, and able MWBE firms to participate. 2. Establish a certification designated for individual determined to be social and economically disadvantaged. 3. Reduce the waiting period for new MWBE firm's principal place of business to be located in the KCMO certifying area from 1 year to six months. 4. Establish a Personal Net Worth test for MWBE firms that is equivalent to the DOT program. 5. Allow MWBE prime contractors self-perform work to count towards meeting the recommended goals 6. Apply the MWBE Program requirements elements and administration fully to the statutory agencies, and allow the Fairness in Construction Board to established MWBE goals on statutory agency projects, as well as hear appeals, and render findings on penalties and damages. 7. Established a sunset date for the City's MWBE program. 8.. Allow MWBE firms to remain certified indefinitely, as long as they meet the code requirements.
