

ORDINANCE NO. 240507

Accepting funds allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, FY 2023 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$315,838; estimating and appropriating \$315,838 in the Justice Assistance Grant Fund; designating requisitioning authorities; and directing the City Clerk to file certain documents with the appropriate offices.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council acknowledge and accept the funds allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance provided under an agreement with the Jackson County Prosecutor's Office, from the 2023 Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$315,838. Jackson County Prosecutor's Office will act as fiscal agent for 2023 Justice Assistance Grant.

Section 2. That the revenue in the following account of the 2023 Justice Assistance Grant Fund is hereby estimated in the following amount:

Section 3. That \$315,838 is appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Justice Assistance Grant Fund to the following accounts:

Section 4. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Contract with Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission, in the amount of \$150,000.00. The agreement is approved in substantial form, as that on file with the City Clerk.
