The contract involves repairing streets and adjacent curbs, sidewalks, driveways, yards, and other site-specific work as needed. Which is to restore areas damaged due to water main breaks, sanitary sewer and storm water infrastructure improvements and includes resurfacing roads over water main replacement construction projects to bring them to new SR-1 standards.

The work will also include the transferring of customers water service connections from existing water mains to new water mains. The amount of this contract is \$4,091,108.00. The term of this contract is for 425 calendar days.

This proposed \$324,490.00 Amendment No.3 for a design professional contact with Water Solutions for Storm water On-Call Small Local Business Enterprise (SLB Enterprise). The work identifies flood risks within the community leveraging the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Physical modeling work in the Indian Creek is also with Water Resource Solutions. This allows better flood risk warnings from the 2-year change to 500-year storm. These will be built into the flood warning system for both Indian and Dykes Branch Creeks, aiding public safety and recovery.

231027- Jeff Martin, Water Department spoke on this ordinance. This construction project is in the amount of \$6,522,244.00. It is to improve distribution system reliability, increase hydraulic conveyance capacity, and support fire protection to replace aging, break-prone cast iron water mains with ductile iron pipe. This project consists of replacing approximately 15,100 linear feet of 6-inch, 8-inch, 12-inch, and 24-inch break-prone or obsolete water mains within the project limits (defined as E. Truman Road to E. 24th Street, Walnut Street to Wabash Avenue, in Kansas City). The work will include the transfer of customers' water service connections from existing water mains to new water mains.

231020 -Nicholas Bosonetto, Public Works Department gave an in-depth overview of the ordinance. There was dialogue between the committee and city staff. Approval of the ordinance will waive certain procedures of the City's arterial street impact fee code; appropriating \$1,898,959.00 from the Birmingham Impact District. These funds can only be spent within each Impact District Boundary, according to Chapter 39 of the code. from the unappropriated Fund Balance of the Arterial Street Impact Fee Fund. The ordinance will appropriate \$1,289,645.00 from Clay County Road & Bridge Tax funds which is held in the Parvin Road project account. It will also estimate to appropriate \$1,297,526.00 in Series 2023A General Obligation Bonds and authorizing the execution of a funding agreement with the Tax Increment Financing Commission and Hunt Midwest for the widening of NE 48th Street from I-435 East to the dead-end **street**.
