Brief Title Approving a contract for the replacement of water mains in the area of Oakley Avenue to Marsh Avenue, E. 20th Street to E. 34th Street

Reason To authorize execution of a construction contract and expenditures; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

Details

Reason for Contract
 Authorizing a contract for approximately \$1,961,000.00 with Blue Nile Contractors, Inc., for the replacement of water mains in the area of Oakley Avenue and Marsh Avenue, E. 20th Street to E. 34th Street; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$2,160,000.00; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective

Discussion
Project Justification
 This project will replace approximately 10,600 linear feet (LF) of break-prone water mains in the area of Oakley Avenue to Marsh Avenue, E. 20th Street to E. 34th Street.

Project Description
 This project consists of replacing approximately 10,600 LF of existing aging break-prone water mains with 5,200 LF of 6" ductile iron pipe (DIP), 2,400 LF of 8" DIP, and 3,000 LF of 12" DIP. Replacement of water mains will be in the following areas:

- Along Bellaire Avenue from E. 32nd Street to E. U.S. 40 Highway with 6" DIP;
- Along Bonita Avenue from Topping Avenue to E. 28th Terrace with 6" DIP;
- Along Lawndale Avenue from E. 27th Street to E. 26th Street with 6" DIP;
- Along E. 27th Street from Topping Avenue to 150 ft east of White Avenue with 6" DIP;
- Along E. 26th Terrace from Topping Avenue to White Avenue with 6" DIP;
- Along White Avenue from E. 27th Street to E. 26th Street with 6" DIP;
- Along Oakley Avenue from E. 22nd Street to E. 20th Street with 6" DIP;
- Along E. 20th Street from Topping Avenue to E. 21st Street with 6" DIP;
- Along E. 23rd Trafficway from 250 ft east of Wheeling Avenue to Bennington Avenue with 8" DIP;
- Along Topping Avenue from E. 28th Terrace to Bonita Avenue with 8" DIP; and
- Along E. U.S. 40 Highway from Manchester Trafficway to southbound I-435 off-ramp with 12" DIP.

This work will include the transfer of customer water service connections from existing mains to new mains, as well as restoration of roads and property.

All project work will be completed within Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, in Council District 3.
