

The KC Blueprint for Violence Prevention and a Safe and Healthy Community

- The KC Blueprint was adopted in 2020 by City Council.
- City Council voted to allocate funds to support KC Blueprint strategies in March 2023.
- Health Dept stated the importance of an evaluation of the community approach to violence prevention/intervention.



Evaluation Process

- **Goal Setting:**
 - Develop a logic model for each evaluation
 - Formulate evaluation questions
 - Define measurable outcomes
- **Data Collection:**
 - Create quantitative and qualitative methods to gather data
 - Conduct experimental design
 - Create a centralized secure database.
- **Informed Decision-Making:**
 - Analyze Data
 - Report findings
 - Community partners are aided to refine their strategies using evidence-based findings

Contract Details

- UMKC will contract with the Health Department to assist in the evaluation of all violence prevention efforts funded by the Violence Prevention and Intervention Fund.
- \$250,000/year
