 Authorizing a \$1,422,500.00 contract with MegaKC Corporation for the Post Gate 6 upgrade at KCI Airport; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$1,564,750.00.

 This project upgrades the security entrance and exit at Post Gate 6 for the purpose of providing a reliable new east route for de-icing and fuel trucks to service the New Terminal and Overhaul Base.

**Project Description**  
 The project will replace the current gate with a new rolling gate and card readers, construct a new concrete entrance and exit road on Oslo Dr. and install LED light poles, and complete a mill and asphalt overlay of JP Cooper Rd. to the Terminal C apron.
