110402- Approving and designating Redevelopment Project 3 of the First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Three Trails District Tax Increment Financing Plan as a Redevelopment Project and adopting tax increment financing therefor.

130084- Reducing funding in the amount of \$150,000.00 and appropriating funds to increase funding in the amount of \$150,000.00 in Community Development Block Grant Fund accounts to cover the salary cost for the Director of Neighborhoods and Housing Services.

140658- Repealing Committee Substitute for Ordinance No. 140223.

140494- Vacating the north/south alley between N. Baltimore Avenue and N. Main Street north of N.E. Harlem Road, Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri; retaining a utility easement; and directing the City Clerk to record certain documents. (1686-V)
