

ORDINANCE NO. 180881

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute an agreement in the amount of \$3,013,758.90 with Leavenworth Excavating & Equipment Co. for the N.E. 104th Street Improvements Project; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2016, City Council passed Ordinance No. 160544 approving the Redevelopment Agreement with the Tax Increment Financing Commission for the design and construction of roadways and other public infrastructure on N.E. 104th Street between Missouri 291 Highway and Missouri A Highway; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Leavenworth Excavating & Equipment Co., in the amount of \$3,013,758.90 for construction services in Project No. 89008535, N.E. 104th Street Improvements, from funds previously appropriated to the following account:

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A copy of the contract is on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.


Section 2. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into contract changes up to and including the amount of \$310,000.00 without further authorization of the City Council, for a total contract authorization of \$3,323,758.90, from Account No. 19-3090-898041-B-89008535.

Section 3. That this ordinance, relating to the design, repair, maintenance or construction of a public improvement, is recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)(D) of the City Charter and shall take effect in accordance with Section 503, City Charter.


