This ordinance approves a one year \$83,850.00 contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to conduct Perinatal Hepatitis B case management and surveillance activities in Kansas City, Missouri for identification of pregnant women who are infected with Hepatitis B to provide immunization to the newborn, for household and sexual contacts to prevent Hepatitis B infection. The program routinely maintains 10-20 pregnancies through surveillance efforts and follows an additional 35-50 newborns to ensure appropriate vaccine compliance.

This contract will also assist the department in working toward the Monkey Pox Infection National Strategic Plan outlined by the Department of Health and Senior Services.
