Public Works is utilizing AtkinsRealis to provide consultant services for streetcar vehicle procurement, design and production oversight activities in the Streetcar Main Street Extension Project. The proposed amendment will authorize funds for continuation of these services, including support for the warranty phase of the vehicle procurement through April 2027, and support for completion of existing fleet subsystem retrofits.
