Executive Summary

Directing the City Manager to research and evaluate the feasibility of establishing a temporary modular jail facility to meet the City's current rehabilitation and detention needs.

Discussion

The City has contracts with Johnson County, Missouri and Vernon County, Missouri to provide detention services. The City has outstanding detention and rehabilitation needs. The expected surge of visitors to the City for the upcoming 2026 World Cup may further strain the City's limited rehabilitation and detention resources. Various jurisdictions, including Greene County, Missouri, have utilized modular jail facilities as a temporary solution to detention and rehabilitation needs. Council desires to provide additional, temporary rehabilitation and detention facilities in the form of a temporary modular facility.
