

ORDINANCE NO. 260325

Sponsor: Director of Neighborhood Services

Accepting and approving a \$150,000 grant award from Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), as part of the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality program, to fund the purchase of electric vehicle charging infrastructure and hybrid or electric vehicles; estimating and appropriating \$150,000 in the General Grants Fund , designating requisition authority and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), Title 23 United States Code (USC) §149 authorizes the funding of projects providing for congestion mitigation and air quality (CMAQ); and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation has awarded the City a \$150,000 grant with the City's match of \$37,500 to support the City's electric vehicle charging infrastructure.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to accept a \$150,000 grant from the Missouri Department of Transportation implementation to increase the amount of electric vehicle charging infrastructure and vehicles.

Section 2. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to execute a grant agreement with the Missouri Department of Transportation to govern the administration of the grant. A copy of the grant agreement is on file in the Director of the Neighborhood Services Department.

Section 3. That revenue in the amount of \$150,000 is hereby estimated in the following account of the General Grants Fund:

Section 4. That the sum of \$150,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the General Grants Fund to the following accounts:

Section 5. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is hereby designating authority for Account No. 26-2580-571435-619080-G57DOTHPC26

Section 6. That this ordinance is recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)(C) of the City Charter in that it appropriates money and shall take effect in accordance with that section.

I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
