### **Executive Summary**

Authorizing the Kansas City Tax Increment Financing Commission to surplus the funds remaining in the special allocation fund and the Winchester Housing Improvement Fund; authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Contribution Agreement with the Economic Development Corporation of Kansas City for the purposes of funding the remaining projects selected under the Winchester Housing Improvement Program; estimating and appropriating surplus revenues in the amount of \$187,500 for the purpose of funding two Winchester Housing Improvement Program projects; and designating requisitioning authority.

#### Discussion

This ordinance would transfer the surplussed funds of the Winchester Center special allocation fund and the Winchester Housing Improvement Fund from the General Fund to the Winchester Home Program fund for the purpose of proceeding with two housing repair projects previously approved by the Winchester Center Tax Increment Financing Plan.
