Authorizing an amendment to the 2020 Action Plan for additional funding for a parking lot as a slum and blight remediation activity in the KC CUR Local Strategy Area located in the Key Coaliton Urban Revewal Area.

The parking lot will serve the KCPD Central Patrol public meeting and community engagement spaces, the Morningstar Youth and Family Life Center and the Key Coalition Neighborhood in general by remediating blighting conditions through redevelopment activities.
