## **Executive Summary**

Appropriating \$5,000,000.00 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Conventions and Tourism Fund (2360) for the purpose of fulfilling the City's obligation to KC2026 related to the World Cup and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

### **Discussion**

This ordinance appropriates funds in connection with the City's prior agreements pursuant to Ord No. 170979, Ord No. 230580, and Ord No. 240286 directing the City Manager to include funds specific to obligations.

#### Section 1.

This section specifies that the Fund Balance reserve will be lower than required per the Fund Balance Reserve Policy Code of Ordinances.

#### Section 2.

This section appropriates funds from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Conventions and Tourism Fund (2360) to World Cup Soccer to fulfill the above stated obligation.

#### Section 3.

This section holds the standard language regarding an Ordinance that appropriates money and recognizes the Ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.
