WHEREAS, through local initiatives, partnerships, and community-led efforts, Kansas City is proud to uplift the voices of immigrants and support the efforts of organizations that promote pathways to citizenship, advocate for equity, and foster belonging for all; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That the Mayor and Council honor the resilience, achievements, and contributions of immigrants throughout our city's history and recognize June 2026 as National Immigrant Heritage Month in Kansas City, Missouri; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be spread upon the Minutes of the Council in testimony thereof and that a copy hereof be presented to Eye of an Immigrant, the Mayor's Commission for New Americans, and members of Kansas City's Immigrant Community, with the Mayor and Council inviting all Kansas Citians to join in celebrating the vibrant cultures and stories that make Kansas City a stronger and more united community.
