- Solicitation Waiver
- Approval to exceed \$400,000.00 on contract EV4010 annually
- Approval to execute an agreement to install network upgrades on contract EV4009
- MWBE goals are waived per CREO on both contracts EV4010 and EV4009

Impacts

Impacts (continued)

- The investment of \$2.3 million in an upgraded Wi-Fi infrastructure for the Convention and Entertainment Facilities Department's exhibitor network enhances connectivity and the overall user experience.
