The purpose of the District is to provide funding for demolition and the construction of certain improvements and the provision of certain services within the District's boundaries. The improvements initially contemplated include demolition of existing structures, site work, grading, infrastructure improvements, parking improvements/structures, additional improvements/structures, utility improvements, right-of-way improvements, landscaping, lawns, and trees, as well as any other improvements (the "Improvements") or services (the "Services") permitted by the CID Act.
