Executive Summary

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute a design-build contract with Gunter Construction Company in the amount of \$2,887,595.00 for the 31st St Connector Plan Phase 1 Sidewalks project, from Main Street to Gillham Plaza; authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into contract changes up to and including twenty percent (20%) of the original contract price; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.
