#### **Executive Summary**

Authorizing the City Manager to execute a petition to establish the Crossroads Community Improvement District.

#### **Discussion**

This resolution would allow the City Manager to sign a petition to establish the Crossroads CID on behalf of the City as a property owner within the proposed boundary. This would not establish the CID, but would simply allow the City Manager on behalf of the City be one of the property owners signing the petition. Authorization from City Council for the City Manager to sign a petition to establish a CID on behalf of the City is required by Section 74-302(d). City staff has reviewed the petition to verify it meets City code and State Statutes.

The proposed CID would have a 10-year term and encompass the majority of properties in the area commonly know as the Crossroads Art District. The petition proposes enhanced and additional landscape/streetscaping, landscaping maintenance, graffiti removal, trash/waste management, First Friday event management, and security within the CID. The proposed source of revenue will be a 0.5% sales tax and a special assessment of property based on the land use and square footage of a parcel. The City, as a property owner, will not be required to pay the proposed special assessment, but may choose to make voluntary payments in any amounts in lieu of such special assessment.
