The Adopted FY11-15 CIP allocated \$5,154,002 towards improvements to Waukomis/Green Hills Road from NW 68th Street to Barry Road. Phase 1 of these improvements were completed under project 89008148 and remaining funds are being used to complete the design of Phase 2 improvements.
