There is currently a capital campaign to build a new Northland Workforce Development Center to expand the programs offered and number of students and adults enrolled. The State of Missouri has appropriated \$37,000,000.00 to be used to match contributions to the project. The City wishes to explore the use of certain sources of funds to be dedicated to providing local matching funds for this project.
