Amending Chapter 76, Code of Ordinances, by repealing and replacing Sections 76-289, 76-423 and 76-427, and amending Chapter 70, Code of Ordinances, by repealing and replacing Section 70-273, for the purpose of amending regulations relating to tow truck operators within the City.

Matthew Muckenthaler, Public Works Department, Natalie Cofield, Kansas City Police Department, and Jim Ready, Regulated Industries, presented. This ordinance updates the city's towing regulations by removing and replacing specific sections of the Code; the revisions clarify and strengthen rules for tow truck operators, covering who may operate a tow truck, how and where towing may take place, and what fees or penalties apply, with the overall goal of modernizing standards to ensure safety, fairness, and accountability in towing across Kansas City.
