ORDINANCE NO. 250524

- Continue services for technical and financial analyses to complete the Integrated Management Plan (IMP) and to support consent decree modifications
- Hydraulic modeling services to verify:
 - > Performance of completed overflow control projects
 - > Achievement of Consent Decree performance criteria for the 2024 interim milestone
 - > Projection of system performance at future 2030 and 2035 interim milestones
 - Collection system performance assessment with future service area expansion opportunities
 - > Impacts of wholesale customer wet weather flows on City's collection system capacity



Regulatory Compliance and CIP Optimization



- Dynamic Smart Sewer Program with Affordability Challenges &
 Wet Weather Overflow Control Optimization Opportunities
- New regulations (P, PFAS/PFOS, Lead & Copper, etc.)
- Use of Consent Decree Financial Safeguard



Integrated Planning is KC Water's approach to achieving regulatory compliance across Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater utilities



Support 4th Consent Decree Modification



What is Integrated Planning?


- EPA's definition: A process that identifies efficiencies from separate wastewater and stormwater programs to best prioritize capital investments and achieve a community's human health and water quality objectives.
- Compliance with State and Federal Regulations is a requirement.





Drivers for Integrated Management Plan (IMP)

- Consent Decree-driven Overflow Control Plan - by 2035 (total planned investment ~ \$2.2B vs forecasted \$3B)
- New plant effluent total phosphorus limit (MoDNR October 2023, ~ \$1B)
- New Water Treatment Plant (~\$740M)
- Lead and Copper Rule Service Line Replacement (2025 – 2034, ~\$20M/year)
- Large stormwater projects for Brush
 Creek and Little Blue River

- Mayoral-appointed Public Advisory Committee
- Objective:
 - To bring together a diverse group of Kansas Citians to collaboratively assess and provide input into KC Water's approach to prioritizing the community's most pressing water, wastewater, and stormwater utility needs and challenges
- Engagement Process:
 - Broad cross-section of community stakeholder groups
 - Educational component on KC Water's water, wastewater, and stormwater systems
 - Feedback focused on consideration of community's needs
