Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program

- Largest federal program dedicated to HIV care
- Serves about half of people with HIV in the U.S. & in the KC-TGA
- “Payer of last resort”

Service Area

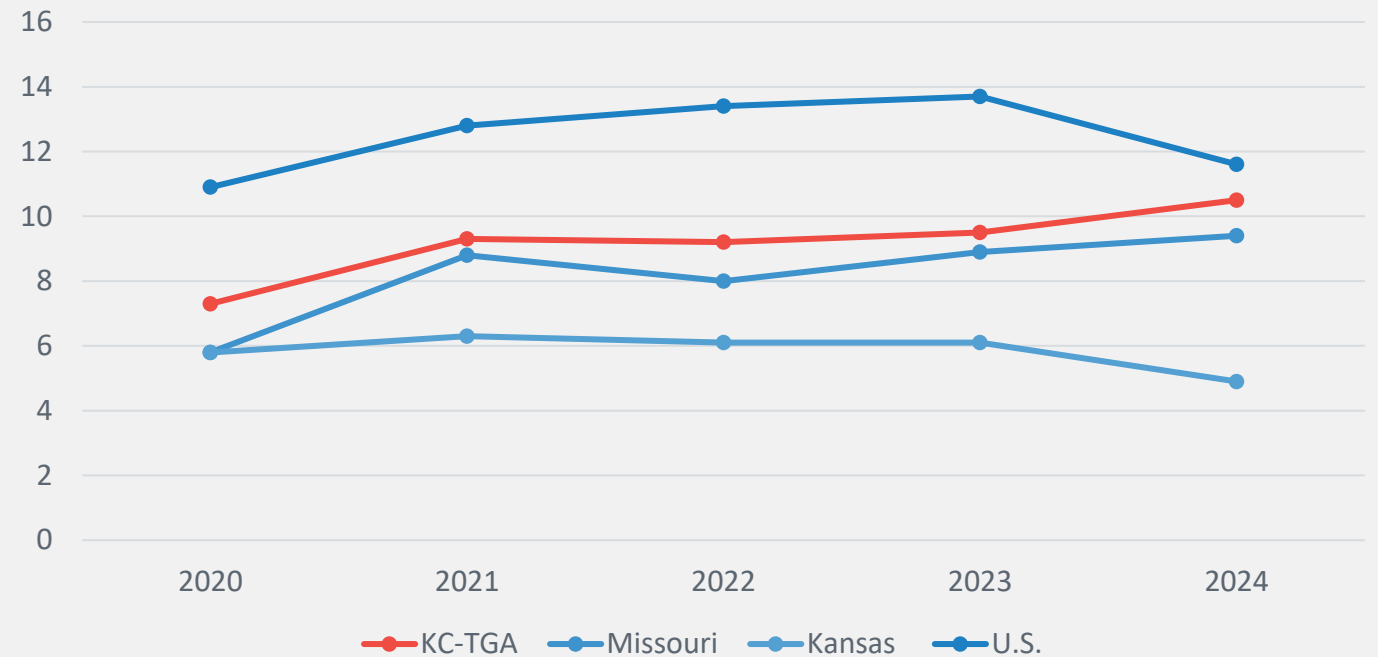
- Kansas City Transitional Grant Area
 - 7 Counties in Missouri
 - 4 Counties in Kansas
 - 2.2 million people
 - 5,600 people with HIV



HIV in the KC-TGA (2024)

- 229 new diagnoses
- Disproportionate impacts among:
 - Black/African Americans
 - Hispanic/Latines
 - Ages 25-34

FY2025 Ryan White Client Demographics

- Race/Ethnicity
 - White: 36%
 - Black: 43%
 - Hispanic: 19%
 - Asian/Pacific Islander: 2%
 - Native American/Alaska Native: 1%
- Age
 - 13-24: 3%
 - 25-44: 45%
 - 45-64: 41%
 - 65+: 10%
- Mode of Exposure
 - Male-to-Male Sex (MSM): 55%
 - Injection Drug Use (IDU): 3%
 - MSM/IDU: 3%
 - Heterosexual: 30%
 - Other: 9%
- Poverty Level
 - < 100% FPL: 56%
 - 101%-300% FPL: 39%
 - 301%-400%: 4%
- Housing Status
 - Stable: 84%
 - Unstable: 16%

Services Provided

- Core Medical
 - Medical Case Management
 - Outpatient/Ambulatory Health Services
 - Oral Health Care
 - Health Insurance Premium & Cost Sharing
 - Mental Health Services
 - Substance Use Services
- Supportive Services
 - Referral for Healthcare & Supportive Services
 - Health Education/Risk Reduction
 - Housing

Unique Requirements

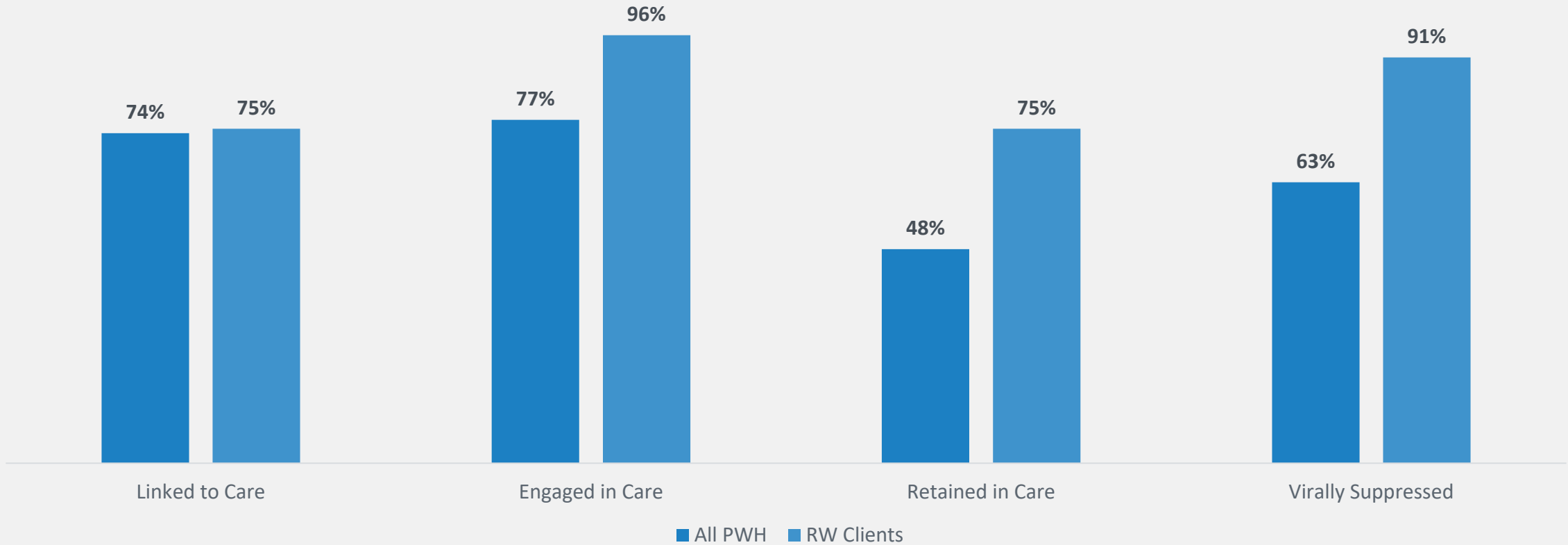
- Targeted funding structure
 - 75% core medical services
- Planning Council input
 - Prioritization of services
 - Resource allocation
- Quality Management program

Local Investment

- Majority of funding goes to community partners to deliver services
- Kansas City contributes some matching funds
 - ~5% of total anticipated funding
