PURPOSES OF CID AND SERVICES PERFORMED DURING FISCAL YEAR 2024

Purpose:

- a) provide or cause to be provided for the benefit of the District, certain services described in Paragraph 3B of the Petition (the "Eligible Services");
- b) borrow money ("CID Debt") from any public or private source to finance the costs of the Eligible Services and other costs incurred by the District to carry out its purposes and for the repayment of the same, provided that the District's borrowing capacity shall be limited to \$1,581,008 ("CID Debt Cap"); and
- c) authorize and collect sales and use tax ("District Sales Tax").

Services:

The Eligible Services may generally include, but are not necessarily limited to, earthwork, installation of geo-piers, paving and construction of parking lots, water distribution, a fire line, storm drainage, sanitary sewer and sanitary sewer relocation, landscaping, green space and irrigation, construction of curbs, gutters, approaches, sidewalks and electrical distribution, streetlights, and site lighting, and overall rehabilitation of the District. The estimated initial costs of the Eligible Services are shown on Exhibit C of the Petition ("Estimated Cost of Eligible Services") annexed to and made an integral part of this Petition.




WHEREAS, in accordance with the District's bylaws the Board is to elect officers at the annual meeting of the District; and

Section 2. The Chairman is authorized and directed to take all further action necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this Resolution.



**TIFFANY SQUARE EAST COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
MAY 1, 2024 – APRIL 30, 2025 BUDGET (FY-2025)
BUDGET MESSAGE:**

The Tiffany Square East Community Improvement District (the "District") was formed as a political subdivision of the State of Missouri on February 10, 2022 by virtue of Ordinance No. 220088 approved by the City Council of Kansas City, Missouri. The District will serve as an economic development tool that allows landowners in the District to provide public and private improvements. The District has adopted a fiscal year of May 1st to April 30th.

Important Budget Features:

The District's source of revenue is a 1.0% sales and use taxes pursuant to the Missouri Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67-1545 to 67-1551 of the Missouri Statutes and approved by the qualified voters of the District by a sales tax election held on August 19, 2022.

The District was formed for the purpose of providing revenue for the following district purposes (collectively the "District Purposes"): (1) provide or cause to be provided, within and for the benefit of the District, (a) construction of vehicular and pedestrian accessibility improvements, (b) remediation of subsurface conditions which are presently unsuitable for fill and development, and shall specifically include earthwork, installation of geo-piers, paving and construction of parking lots, water distribution, a fire line, storm drainage, sanitary sewer and sanitary sewer relocation, landscaping, green space and irrigation, and (c) construction of curbs, gutters, approaches, sidewalks and electrical distribution, street lights, and site lighting (collectively, the "Eligible Services"); (2) issue obligations ("CID Debt") to finance (a) the costs of the Eligible Services, (b) other costs incurred by the District to carry out its purposes, (c) costs of issuance, (d) capitalized interest and (e) a debt service reserve fund related to the issuance of the CID Debt; (3) authorize and collect a sales and use tax; and (4) provide for any other actions required in the furtherance of the above stated objectives, as the District's Board of Directors deems necessary, and as authorized pursuant to Section 67.1401, *et seq.*, RSMo, as may be amended.
