## REGULATION NUMBERS 66035 THROUGH 66039 INSTALLATIONS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (b) of Section 70-38 of the “Code of General Ordinances of Kansas City, Missouri” and subject to the provisions thereof, traffic regulations are hereby made and adopted as follows:

All vehicular traffic shall **Stop** before entering the following intersection(s) and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-335**:

<b><u>Regulation Number</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Direction of Restriction</u></b>
66035	NE Chowning Drive and N Flora Avenue	Southbound

The driver of a vehicle shall **Yield The Right-of Way** to all vehicles approaching the following intersection(s) (in the direction bound as indicated) when Yields are in place, and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-335**:

<b><u>Regulation Number</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Direction of Restriction</u></b>
66036	N Ditzler Avenue and NE 94th Street	Westbound

**Stopping, Standing and/or Parking** shall be prohibited (as indicated) on the following street(s) and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-530**:

<b><u>Regulation Number</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Restriction</u></b>
66037	50 <sup>th</sup> Terrace, north side, from Wyoming Street to Westwood Terrace	No Parking Anytime
66038	Oak Street, west side, from 11 <sup>th</sup> Street then north 65 feet	No Parking Anytime

Reserved parking for **Physically Disabled Persons** is hereby established, as indicated below, and shall be added to the lists as contained in **Sections 70-534** and **70-535**:

<b><u>Regulation Number</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Restriction</u></b>
66039	Oak Street, west side, from a point 65 feet north of 11 <sup>th</sup> Street then north 45 feet	Accessible Parking

The locations affected by the above regulations will be marked in accordance with standards prescribed in the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways” and said regulations shall become effective five days after publication in The Daily Record.
