Amending Chapter 50, Code of Ordinances, by enacting a new Section 50-177, "Domestic Assault", for the purpose of instituting a specific municipal ordinance violation for domestic assault.

Previously, City prosecutors charged instances of assault involving domestic victims under Code Section 50-169. This ordinance institutes a new City ordinance violation specifically for domestic assault and includes provisions which mirror the state charge for domestic assault in the fourth degree found in Chapter 565.076, RSMo.
