Executive Summary

Authorizing Amendment No. 3 to a design professional services agreement with WSP, Inc. in the amount of \$695,794.23 for the Grand Boulevard Bridge Bike/Pedestrian Accommodations project, bringing the total contract amount to \$1,797,249.16; and recognizing an accelerated effective date.

Discussion

This ordinance authorizes a Design Professional services contract with WSP to provide archaeologic monitoring, railroad coordination, construction inspection and monitoring, and field observation for the construction of the Grand Blvd Bike/Ped Bridge. This structure will provide pedestrian/bike facilities from the Riverfront to the Rivermarkt. The CREO Goals are 15% MBE/10% for Design Professional services.
