BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

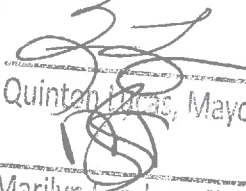
That the Mayor and Council hereby recognize September 28, 2025, as National Good Neighbor Day; and

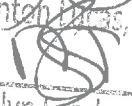
