During the grant period MCH staff will work with a variety of community partners to prevent intentional injuries among children, youth, and adolescents in target ages between 10-19 years old and those that have close relationships with them, such as parents, teachers, and youth leaders, Health Department staff and community partners use research-based curricula that include CDC program elements that have been proven to enhance social skills, build healthy relationships, and decision-making processes to assist in the prevention of violence and suicide.
