Discussion (explain all financial aspects of the proposed legislation, including future implications, any direct/indirect costs, specific account numbers, ordinance On August 2, 2005, the City held an election, at which time the qualified voters of the City approved the issuance of \$250 million of sanitary sewer system revenue bonds for the purpose of extending and improving the wastewater system of the To date, the City has issued \$208.085 million of sanitary sewer system revenue bonds from the 2005 authorization leaving \$41.915 million of authorized but unissued sanitary sewer system revenue bonds. On August 7, 2012, the City held an election, at which time the qualified voters of the City approved the issuance of \$500 million of sanitary sewer system revenue bonds for the purpose of extending and improving the wastewater system of the City, including compliance with the federally mandated Consent Decree of the Overflow Control Program. This ordinance will authorize the issuance of Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$95 million which includes the remaining \$41.915 million remaining 2005 voted authority, \$40.815 million of the 2012 voted authority and \$11.375 million for the refunding of the Sewer 2004A bonds. The Bonds are special, limited obligations of the City payable solely from, and secured by a pledge of the Net Sanitary Sewer Revenues. The taxing power of the City is not pledged to the payment of the Bonds. The Bonds do not constitute a general obligation of the City or an indebtedness of the City within the meaning of any constitutional, statutory or charter provision, limitation or restriction. Certain of the Bond covenants require the City to fix, establish, maintain and

collect rates and charges for the use and services of the Sanitary Sewer System to produce income and revenues sufficient to: (a) pay the costs of the operation and maintenance of the Sanitary Sewer System; (b) pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds when due and (c) enable the City to have in each Fiscal Year Net Sanitary Sewer Revenues Available for Debt Service plus Administrative Fee of not less than 110%.

Reserve Account will be funded either with cash, Permitted Investments or a surety bond policy only if and when the Net Sanitary Sewer Revenues available for Debt Service falls below the Bond Reserve Debt Service Coverage

The Series 2012A Reserve Account will not be funded at the time of issuance. The Requirement.

#### **Details**

For a full listing of the proposed projects to be funded, please see the attached list entitled, "Sanitary Sewer 2012 Bond Projects FY 2012-2013." The aforementioned projects have been reviewed by the Finance Department and Bond Counsel and were found to qualify for tax-exempt financing.

The City has retained Gilmore & Bell and Martinez, Madrigal, & Machicao, LLC to serve as co-bond counsel. Martinez , Madrigal, & Machicao, LLC is a Citycertified SLBE and MBE firm. The proposed legal fee is \$25,000 and the expenses are estimated at \$3,000.

Additionally, the City has retained King Hershey, Clayborn & Associates, a Citycertified MBE, DBE and SLBE firm, and Jane Hart Law Offices, a City-certified WBE firm, as co-disclosure counsel. Their estimated legal fee is \$10,000.

The City has also selected FirstSouthwest ("FSW") and Moody Reid Financial Advisors to served as co-financial advisors. The MBE goal for this engagement is 20%. Moody Reid is a City-certified MBE firm. At this time, the financial advisory fees are estimated at \$100,500 plus reimbursable printing and electronic dissemination costs.

Finally, this ordinance approves the selection of Wells Fargo Securities; Siebert, Brandford Shank & Co.; M.R. Beal & Co.; and Valdés & Moreno, a Citycertified firm, to act as underwriters for the Series 2012A Bonds. The MBE participation goal is 20%.

The Bonds are anticipated to be sold in November 2012.

Is it good for the children?

Yes, the wastewater system will be improved for all citizens of Kansas City.

How will this contribute to a sustainable Kansas City? The Bond proceeds will allow the Water Services Department to extend and improve the wastewater system utilizing green solutions which protect the environment.

Financial Impact	Based on the October 5, 2012 analysis prepared by FSW, the total debt service on a \$95 million par amount is estimated at \$156.881 million and average annual debt service is \$6.3 million. The true interest cost is estimated at 4.61%.  The projected net present value savings for the Series 2004A Bonds is \$722,064 or 6.35% of the refunding.  The revenue of the sanitary sewer system will serve as the revenue source for the repayment of the bonds.
