ORDINANCE NO. 230401

Sponsor(s): Councilmembers; Kevin O’Neill, Andrea Bough and Ryana Parks-Shaw

Amending Chapter 3, Code of Ordinances, by repealing Section 3-431, “Setting Goals for Individual Contracts” and enacting in lieu thereof a new section of like number and subject matter regulating the application of numeric MBE/WBE goals on certain projects leased for development or receiving economic development incentives or tax abatement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That Chapter 3, Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended by repealing Section 3-431, “Setting Goals for Individual Contracts” and enacting in lieu thereof a new section of like number and subject matter to read as follows:

Sec. 3-431. Setting goals for individual contracts.

(a) Except for goals to be established by the applicable board as provided in sections 3-450, goals shall be established for individual contracts by the director, as determined pursuant to this section. Goals shall be applied to the total dollar value of the contract, unless otherwise authorized by the director.

(b) Individual contract goals shall be flexible and are to be determined on a contract-by-contract basis. In determining whether goals should be established for an individual contract or in setting the specific goal for an individual contract, the following shall be considered:

- (1) The scope of work; and
- (2) The number and types of qualified MBEs and WBEs available to perform such work, or portions of it; and
- (3) Whether the contract can be structured to create potential opportunities for qualified MBEs and WBEs to participate as subcontractors, service providers and/or suppliers; and
- (4) The level of participation of certified MBEs and WBEs in similar contracts awarded by other city departments and incentive agencies, and on local projects awarded by the state and federal governments in the previous and current fiscal years; and

- (5) The city department's or incentive agency's progress toward meeting its annual MBE/WBE goals and its expectations as to how future contracts will be used toward meeting such goals; and
 - (6) The potential dollar amount of the contract.
- (c) When goals for individual contracts are set, they shall be set as follows:
- (1) For all city and incentive agency professional service and goods and services contracts with an estimated cost of more than \$160,000, by the fairness in professional services and goods board, upon the recommendation of the director, as provided in section 3-450.

(d) When goals are established for a contract, such goals shall be stated in any invitation for bid or request for proposals. No invitation for bid or request for proposals shall be released until goals have been requested and set in accordance with subsection (b) of this section, or until the city department or incentive agency soliciting the contract has been notified by the director that goals will not be established. If the goals are to be set by a board and such board shall have failed to meet for any reason within thirty calendar days from the date upon which such board shall have last convened, then the invitation for bid or request for proposals may be released with the goals as recommended by the director and an addendum thereto shall be issued setting forth the goals once established by the board.

(e) For contracts other than construction contracts and contracts for projects leased for development or receiving economic development incentives or tax abatement as described in section 3-425, the director is authorized to require a bidder or proposer to make good faith efforts to achieve MBE/WBE participation without setting a numeric MBE/WBE goal on the solicitation as long as the director could have set an MBE/WBE goal based on the factors in section 3-431(b).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Code of Ordinances, entitled “Administration,” relating to the Classification and Compensation Plan, is hereby amended by repealing Section 2-1081, Salary schedule for elective positions in the city service, and enacting in lieu thereof new section of like number and subject matter, to read as follows:

Sec. 2-1081. Salary schedule for elective positions in the city service.

(a) The following schedule for elective positions in the City service is hereby adopted as the standard annual salary schedule for the following positions in the city service as set out herein below:

Class Code	Position Title	Annual Salary
0005	Elective Judge of Municipal Court	\$163,082.00
0005	Elective Housing Court Judge of Municipal Court	\$122,312.00

(b) This annual salary will remain the same and will not be increased at the beginning of any new fiscal year until the salary of a Missouri Circuit Court Judge exceeds this salary. At the beginning of any new fiscal year after the salary of a Missouri Circuit Court Judge exceeds the salary listed in subsection (a), the annual salary of a Judge of the Municipal Court shall equal the salary of a Circuit Court Judge.

(c) The annual salary of the part-time Housing Court Judge set out above is based upon a thirty (30) hour workweek. This annual salary may be enlarged from time to time to accommodate changes in workload as designated by Council pursuant to the formula provided in Section 2-1404, Code of Ordinances.

WHEREAS, the City, Local No. 42, I.A.F.F. and Local No. 3808, I.A.F.F. have met and discussed plans to better meet the needs of retirees; and

WHEREAS, the City by separate side letter agreements with Local No. 42, I.A.F.F. and Local No. 3808, I.A.F.F. agreed that the respective Collective Bargaining Agreements should be amended to increase retiree health insurance subsidy contributions by current members of the Firefighters' Pension System and by the City and that the necessary ordinance changes to effect such increase should thereby be made; and

WHEREAS, the City and Local No. 42, I.A.F.F. and Local No. 3808, I.A.F.F. have concluded that an increase to the retiree health insurance subsidy will provide the greatest benefit to retirees and the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-1954(h) of the Code of Ordinances prohibits allocations from the unappropriated general fund balance outside of the annual budget process or quarterly budget analysis except in the case of a state of emergency or whenever the allocation is accompanied by a commensurate increase or decrease in revenue in another general fund obligation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the side letter agreement with Local No. 42, I.A.F.F. and the side letter agreement with Local No. 3808, I.A.F.F. agreeing to increase retiree health insurance subsidy contributions are each adopted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute

amendments to Article IX, Section 3, of the 2021-2024 Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local No. 42, I.A.F.F. and to Article IX, Section 5, of the 2021-2025 Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local No. 3808, I.A.F.F. increasing retiree health insurance subsidy contributions by current members of the Firefighters' Pension System and by the City. A copy of each agreement is on file in the office of the City Manager.

Section 2. That these amendments to the 2021-2024 Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local No. 42, I.A.F.F. and to the 2021-2025 Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local No. 3808, I.A.F.F. are authorized to increase the contribution of current members of the Firefighters' Pension System to two percent (2%) of regular payroll and to increase the contribution of the City to four percent (4%) of regular payroll toward the established fund.

Section 3. That the limitations set in place by Code of Ordinance Sec. 2-1954(h) are hereby waived for the limited purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 4. That the sum of \$1,602,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the General Fund, Fund No. 1000, to the following accounts:

Section 4. That Chapter 2, Code of Ordinances of the City of Kansas City, Missouri, is hereby amended by repealing Section 2-1083 enacting in lieu thereof a new section of like number and subject matter, to read as follows.

Sec. 2-1083. Salary schedule for Mayor.

(a) The following schedule for mayor in the city service is hereby adopted as the standard annual salary schedule for the following position in the city service as set out herein below:

Amending Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Kansas City, Missouri, Classification and Compensation Plan, by repealing Sections 2-1076, 2-1077, 2-1078, 2-1079, and 2-1080 and enacting in lieu thereof sections of like numbers and subject matters to create four new job classifications; retitles two job classifications; and adjusts the pay grades for four job classifications.

Discussion

Creating two new job classifications per Council Resolution No. 230256 for the Supported Employee Administrative and Labor workers. Retitles Budget Analyst to Financial Analyst, NHS Division Manager to NCSD Division Manager and creates a Housing Division Manager for that department.

Individuals in these job classifications will receive a title change alone. Changing pay grades for the Airport Police Division to include Airport Police Officer from NE5 to NE6; Airport Police Sergeant from NE7 to NE9; Airport Police Lieutenant from EX3 to EX4 and Airport Police Detective from NE6 to NE7 due to recruitment, retention, and staffing issues at the upgraded airport. The new airport has been challenging to staff at all necessary shifts, and losing employees to other municipalities that are more competitive. At the request of the Mayor’s Office, they would like to add a new job classification of Chief Aide to the Mayor that would better define the duties of that position.

ORDINANCE NO. 230324

Sponsor: Director of the Parks and Recreation Department

Calling for submission to the voters of Kansas City, at a special election to be held on August 8 or November 7, 2023, a question to remove certain city property devoted to park use in the park system generally located between N. Oak Trafficway to the west, N. Holmes to the east and north of N.E. 32nd Terrace; directing the City Clerk to notify the responsible election authorities of the election on or before May 30, 2023, for the August election or on or before August 29, 2023 for the November election; and recognizing this ordinance with an accelerated effective date.

WHEREAS, certain vacant land containing approximately 5.399 acres was obtained by the City and dedicated for park purposes (“Land”); and

WHEREAS, certain property is undeveloped wooded land with steep terrain and which is divided by existing North Cherry Street, and borders existing levee to the south.

WHEREAS, the legal description for the land is as follows: Generally located between North Oak Trafficway to the west, North Holmes to the east and north of Northeast 32nd Terrace for park purposes and more specifically described as follows; A tract of land located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 50 North, Range 33 West, in Kansas City, Clay County, Missouri, being more particularly described as follows: Sec 11-50-33 Se1/4 Braecklein's Subdivision pt Lts 6 & 15 beg 120' n of nw cor N Holmes & N.E. 32nd St, n 450, w 655, nw 632, s 100, se to pob; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 1004(b), if any property is determined by the Board of Parks and Recreation Commissioners to be no longer necessary or appropriate for park, parkway, or boulevard use, such property may be removed from the park system by a vote of the people; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2022, the Board of Parks and Recreation Commissioners approved Resolution No. 32061 which allows the removal of certain property from the park system in since it was deemed no longer needed for park purposes; and

WHEREAS, such removal would allow the City to dispose of the property as surplus property pursuant to City Charter Section 1210 and any disposal will be made on an open and public competition; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

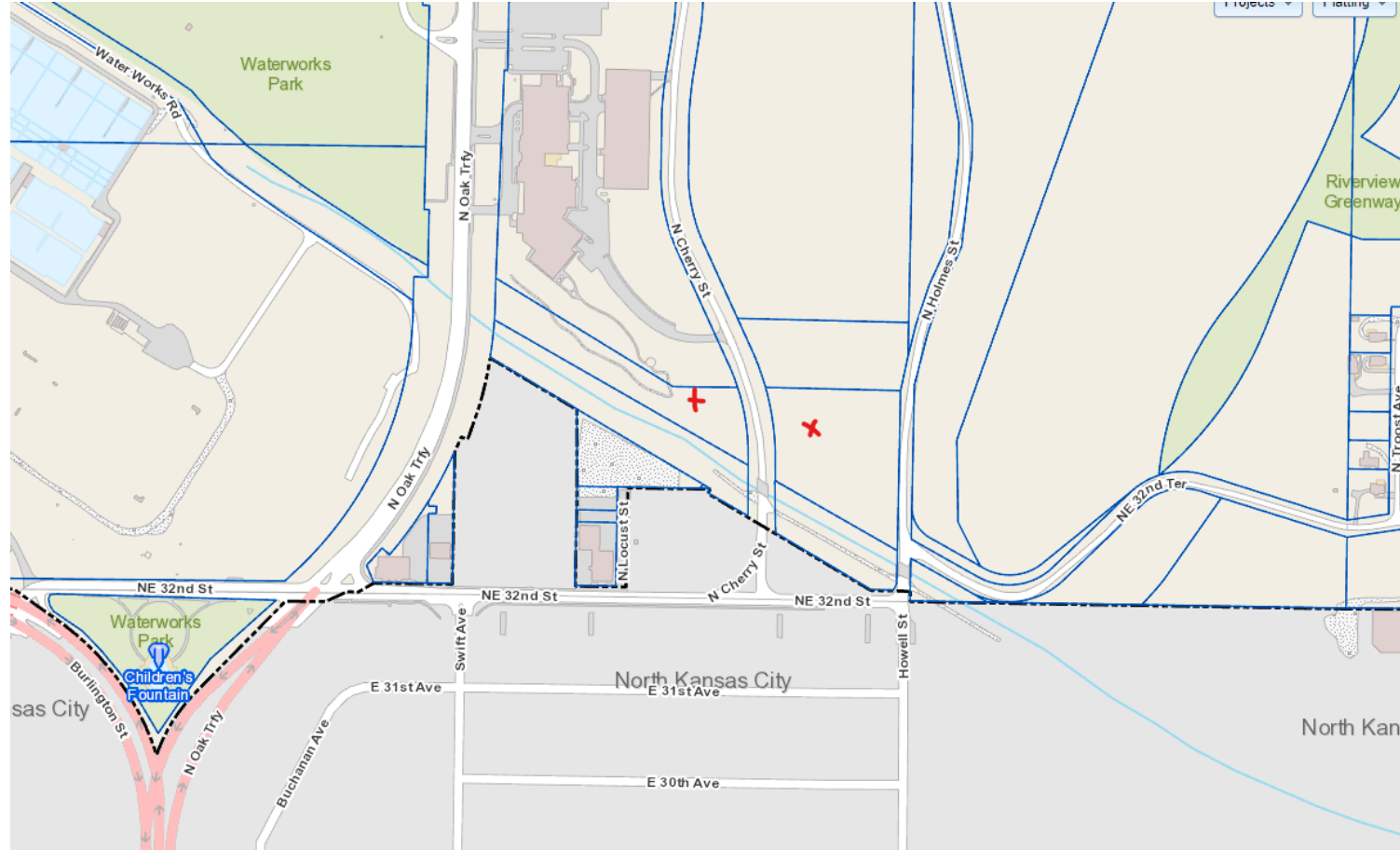

City Charter Section 1004(b) reads: "If any property is determined by the Board of Parks and Recreation Commissioners to be no longer necessary or appropriate for park, parkway, or boulevard use, such property may be removed from the park system by a vote of the people."

Kansas City Parks and Recreation acquired an unnamed parkland in 1957 when the Kansas City annexed land north of the Missouri River. No improvements have been made to the property, not are there any plans for developing this park area. The Board of Parks and Recreation Commissioners has identified this land as being appropriate to decommission.
