Executive Summary

Appropriating \$3,000,000 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the General Fund for the purpose of providing funding for improvements to Starlight Theater and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

Discussion

This ordinance fulfills the requirements of Ordinance 250277, which directs the City Manager to submit an ordinance to the City Council to fund a contribution of up to \$3,000,000 to Starlight Theater subject to the availability of funds following the FY 2025-26 First Quarter Budget analysis.
