Authorizing the renewal of a Cooperative Agreement for Water Purchase between the Consolidated Water Supply District #1 of Platte County, Missouri and Kansas City, Missouri, for a period of twenty-five (25) years.

Hugh Wooden, Phillip Cridlebaugh from Water Services presented. This ordinance authorizes the renewal of a Cooperative Agreement for Water Purchase between the Consolidated Water Supply District #1 of Platte County, Missouri, and Kansas City, Missouri. This wholesale water agreement has been in place for 28 years, and the proposed renewal would extend it for an additional 25 years. The customers served under this agreement is located west of Weatherby Lake. This is one of 34 municipalities to which Kansas City provides wholesale water service, with Lee's Summit being the largest customer. Wholesale water sales account for approximately 10% of Kansas City's water revenue. Kansas City does not maintain infrastructure or services for these municipalities; it simply supplies the water, and the municipalities handle distribution and maintenance beyond the delivery point. Authorizing the Director of the Aviation Department to enter into a \$7,368,806.50 construction contract with Ideker Inc., for the 6225050025 - Taxiway B Reconstruction project at the Kansas City Downtown Airport - Wheeler Field (MKC); and appropriating \$8,105,687.15 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Kansas City Aviation Fund.

Jade Liska and Mike Waller from the Aviation department presented. This ordinance authorizes the Director of the Aviation Department to enter a construction contract with Ideker, Inc. in the amount of \$7,368,806.50 for the Taxiway B Reconstruction Project (Project No. 6225050025) at the Kansas City Downtown Airport - Wheeler Field (MKC). It also appropriates \$8,105,687.15 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Kansas City Aviation Fund to support this project. This project involves a full realignment of Taxiway B and is part of a broader series of improvements that have previously been presented to the City Council. The project is funded through a 90/10 cost-share between the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the City of Kansas City. During the presentation, it was noted that blue areas on the project map represent new taxiway sections, while red areas indicate existing pavement that will be removed and replaced. The improvements aim to enhance situational awareness and airport safety, helping to prevent runway incursions by ensuring proper separation and alignment between taxiways and runways. Representatives from Ideker, Inc., were present and available for questions. A copy of the presentation is on file with the City Clerk's Office.

Authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to execute a \$1,705,000.00 Contract Amendment No. 5 with Doxim Utilitec, LLC, for continued services under the Water Bill Printing and Mailing Services project, to add a one (1) year contract extension for a total contract amount of \$4,360,251.23; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

Phillip Criddlebaugh, Water Services Department presented. This ordinance authorizes the Manager of Procurement Services to execute Contract Amendment No. 5 with Doxim Utilitec, LLC in the amount of \$1,705,000.00, for continued services under the Water Bill Printing and Mailing Services project. This amendment includes a one-year contract extension, bringing the total contract amount to \$4,360,251.23, and recognizes the ordinance as having an accelerated effective date. This contract covers the printing and postage costs associated with water service billing. As part of recent enhancements, Doxim Utilitec has introduced video billing, which can be customized based on individual water usage. The cost of this video billing option is approximately \$80,000, which is comparable to the cost of traditional mailed bills. C.W. French inquired about the possibility of providing incentives for paperless billing to reduce postal costs. A discussion followed regarding potential strategies to encourage broader adoption of electronic billing while avoiding the financial limitations imposed by the Hancock rule. The Water Services Department indicated that it would explore additional alternatives and incentives to help reduce overall postage and mailing costs.
