The resolution supports an application for the FY 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant.

Discussion

The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) supports a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution and court programs, prevention and education programs, and crime victim and witness initiatives.

Grant regulations require that the City of Kansas City, Missouri, Jackson County and the City of Grandview, Missouri submit a joint application. All must agree on the allocation of the grant and submit a joint application. The joint application specifies the award distribution to each unit of local government and the purposes for which the funds will be used. The City of Kansas City, Missouri will serve as fiscal agent.

The resolution reflects the agreement that was reached.

The City of Kansas City, Missouri will use its allocation to support the Kansas City No Violence Alliance, the Second Chance Re-entry Program and the Neighborhood and Housing Services Department.

The allocated amount for Kansas City will be \$250,892.00.
