<p>Discussion <i>(including relationship to other Council actions)</i></p> <p>This grant extension provides funding for one Victim Assistant and one part-time Victim Assistant who provide services to victims of domestic violence whose cases appear in Kansas City Municipal Court during the time period not covered while new grant applications were being processed. This grant provides funding in the following amounts:</p> <p>\$5,887.35 for the full time hourly wage, medical and pension benefits for a Victim Assistant and for the hourly wage and medical for the part-time Victim Assistant for the extension time period.
