ORDINANCE NO. 200814

Authorizing the Manager of Procurement Services to execute a one (1) year contract with Conrad Fire Equipment Inc., as the dealer for the purchase of twelve (12) Ambulances; and authorizing five (5) successive one-year renewal options without further City Council approval.

WHEREAS, Section 3-4l(a)(2), Code of Ordinances, requires the Manager of Procurement Services, to obtain City Council authorization to enter into contracts that may exceed \$1,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2020, the Council approved Ordinance No. 200499 authorizing the Master Lease Purchase Agreement for the acquisition and funding for twelve (12) ambulances in Fiscal Year 2020-21; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department estimates the expenditure of over \$3,600,000.00 per year, with an estimated total expenditure of \$17,000,000.00 over the next five (5) fiscal years for the purchase total of 60 ambulances; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Manager of Procurement Services is authorized to execute a one (1) year contract with Conrad Fire Equipment Inc., as the dealer for the purchase of twelve (12) Fire Department Ambulances.

Section 2. That the Manager of Procurement Services is authorized to extend the Conrad Fire Equipment Inc., contract for up to five (5) additional one-year periods without City Council approval.

The City has no financial obligation under both this Ordinance and Contract until the Manager of Procurement Services issues a Purchase Order which shall be signed by the City's Director of Finance certifying there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment will be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation incurred in the Purchase Order.
