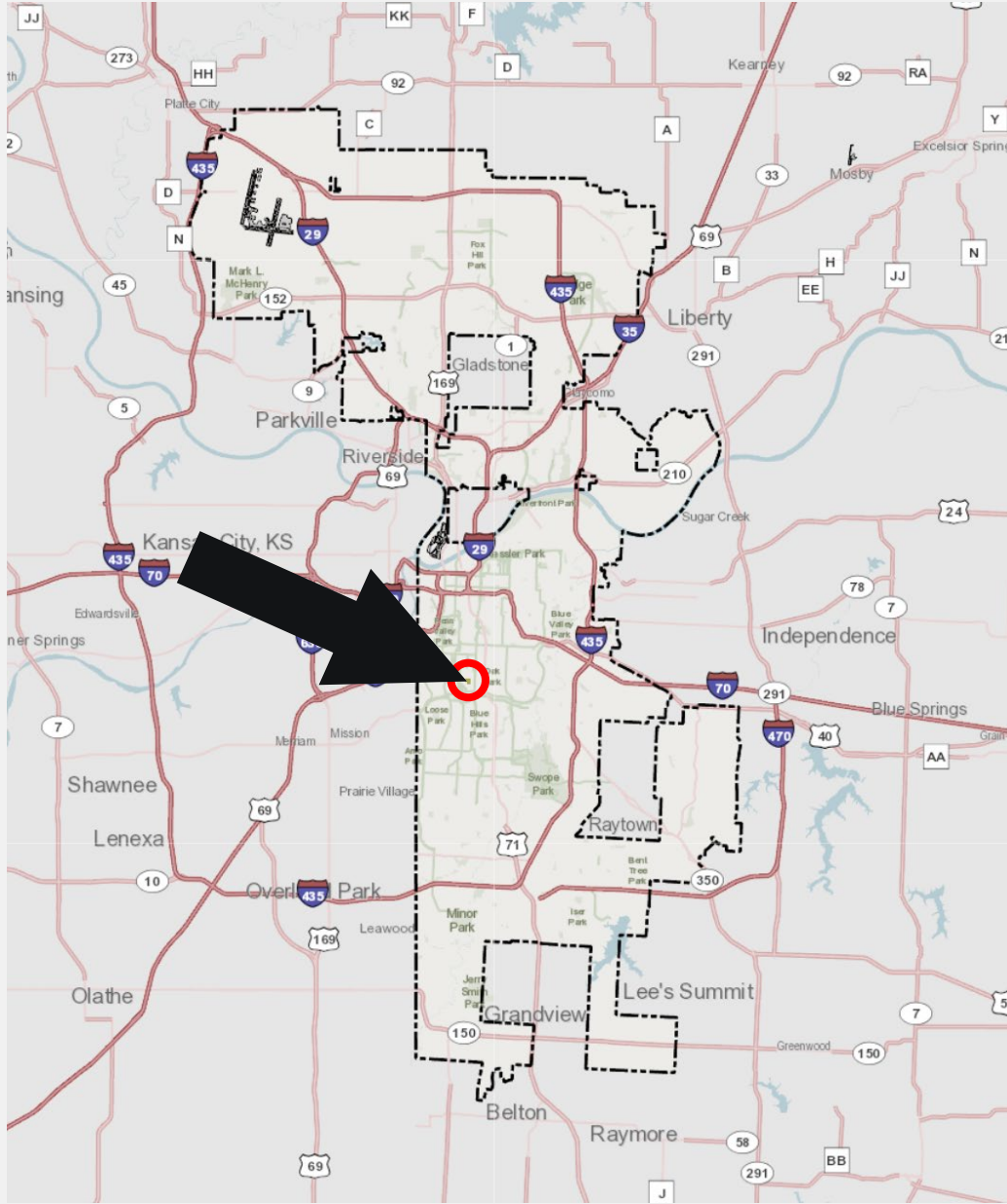

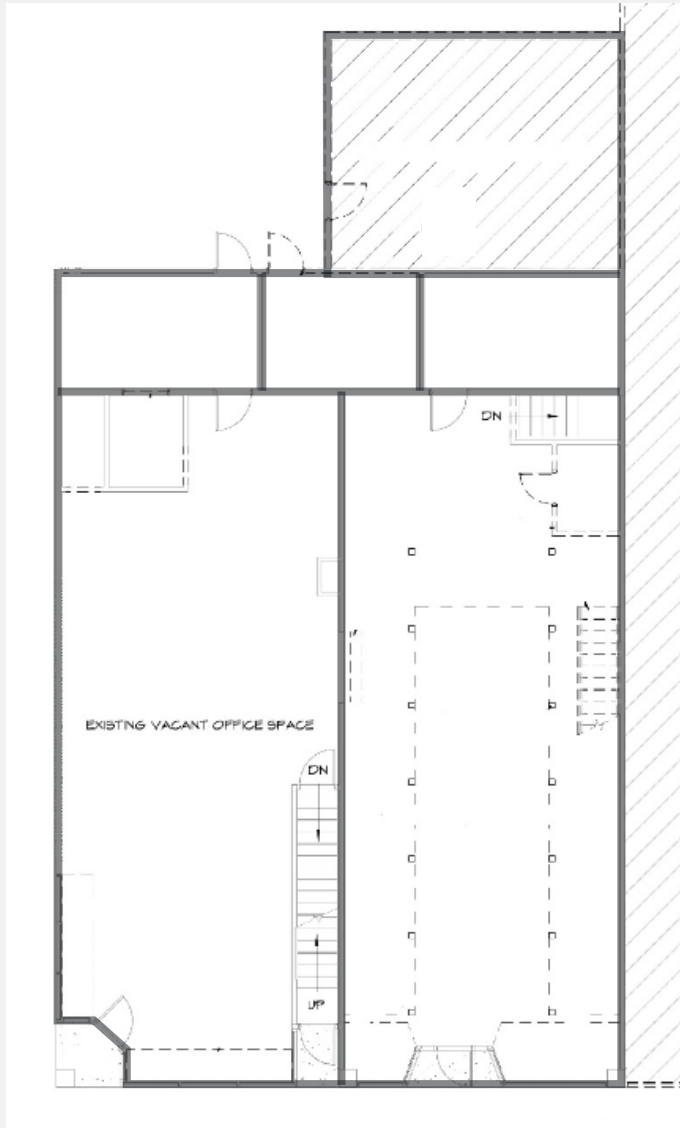




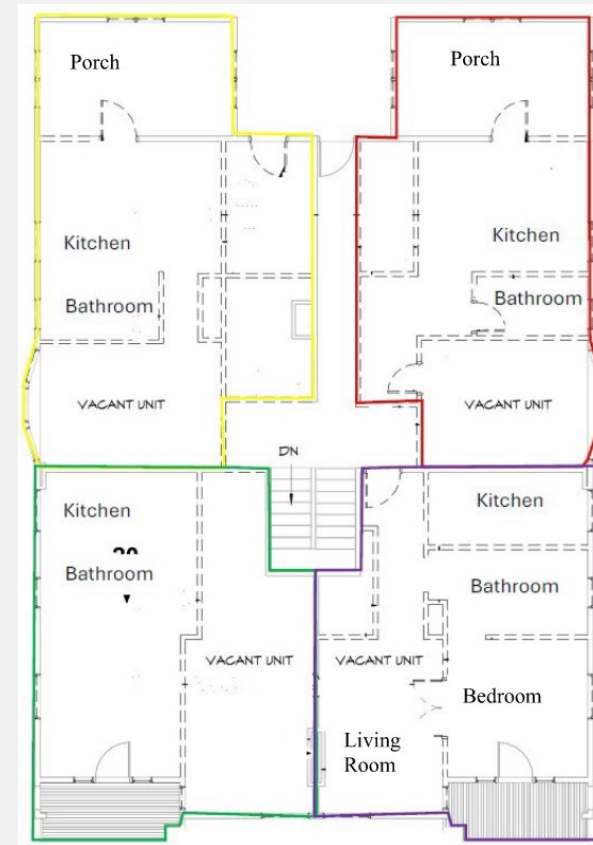

- **The economic impact of the designation on the subject property and the surrounding area.**

There hasn't been any evidence submitted on the economic impact of the designation on the Bancroft Apartments, however the parallel effort to designate on the National Register will make the property eligible for Historic Tax Credits that will enable rehabilitation.

- **Conformance with the city's adopted plans and planning policies**

The Midtown/Plaza Area Plan supports the recommendation to designate the Bancroft Apartments. This mixed-use apartment building aligns with Area Plan recommendations for this portion of Troost Avenue (Area I) to develop as a multimodal neighborhood-serving mixed-use corridor. The Historic Overlay would reinforce the Area Plan recommendation for this parcel to Maintain Predominant Form, noting that "building maintenance and rehabilitation are important for these areas."
