## **Details**

This solution can easily evolve into a High Leverage Network capable of supporting a wide range of future requirements. The new Ethernet network will be designed for 99.999% reliability with 160Mbps of capacity. The existing MDR 8000 radios are End of Life, no longer being sold by Nokia/Alcatel and will be reaching End of Support in the near future. At the same time, Motorola is moving to Ethernet based site links with MPLS routing for future system releases, beginning sometime in 2019-2020. For this reason Motorola is proposing to upgrade the microwave radios to support MPLS routing and Ethernet site links.
