

ORDINANCE NO. 180380

Authorizing the City Manager to enter into an employment agreement with Donna Maize; reducing an appropriation in the amount of \$284,846.00 in the Contingent Appropriation account; appropriating that amount from the Unappropriated Fund Balance in the Contingent Appropriation account; authorizing payment into the City of Kansas City, Missouri Firefighters' Pension System Trust to purchase creditable service on behalf of Donna Maize; and recognizing an accelerated effective date.

WHEREAS, Donna Maize has agreed to become Assistant City Manager, leaving her current position as Deputy Fire Chief; and

WHEREAS, Assistant City Manager is an unclassified, at will position; and

WHEREAS, Donna Maize is agreeing to leave the City of Kansas City, Missouri Firefighters' Pension System Trust and will not be a member of the Employees' Retirement System; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the Employment Agreement attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A.

Section 2. That the appropriation in the following account of the General Fund is reduced by the following amount:

19-1000-179990-B	Contingent Appropriation	\$284,846.00
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Section 3. That the sum of \$284,846.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the General Fund to the following account:

19-1000-231000-A	Fire Administration	\$284,846.00
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Section 4. That the City will contribute \$157,589.00 to the City of Kansas City, Missouri Firefighters' Pension System Trust to purchase 2 years and 4 months creditable service on behalf of Donna Maize.

Section 5. That this ordinance, appropriating of money, is hereby recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)(C) of the City Charter and shall take effect in accordance with Section 503 of the City Charter.

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I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
