#### **Details**

The design of Old Tiffany Springs Road needs to begin in November of 2012 in order to meet the summer 2013 construction schedule but the Industrial Development Authority of the County of Platte County will not issue the bonds in time to fund the design of the improvements in a timely manner to meet the project schedule and the City desires to advance and provide funds to the Commission to begin the design of Old Tiffany Springs Road in November of 2012 for which the Commission does not have available sources of revenue. The KCMO Human Relations Department will provide M/WBE compliance

under the jurisdiction of the TIF Commission

## How will this contribute to a sustainable Kansas City?

It will provide the funding mechanism needed for this project to proceed to design and construction. The street improvement is needed to provide pedestrian access to the school and to improve the safety of the unimproved street. The existing road is in poor shape as it is a gravel farm road that has been paved and the reconstruction will reduce annual maintenance expenses.
