TIF Plan Area

The redevelopment area described by the Plan is generally bound by E. $9^{\rm h}$ Street on the north, E. $12^{\rm th}$ Street on the south, Wyandotte Street on the west, and Main Street on the east (the "Redevelopment Area"), all in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri.

Reason For Legislation

The purpose of this Ordinance is for the City Council of Kansas City, Missouri to consider approval of the 15th Amendment to the 11th Street Corridor Tax Increment Financing Plan (the "Plan").

TIF Plan Objectives:

This 15th Amendment modifies (1) the description the improvements and land uses contemplated by Redevelopment Project Y, (2) the boundaries of Redevelopment Project Area Y. The 15th Amendment does not alter or modify the intent of the Plan, as amended, except for those changes specifically mentioned herein.

Intent of the 15th Amendment: The amendment removes 2 surface parking lots from Project Y. The lots were never developed in accordance with the plan, and are no longer needed to be included.
